

Örnsköldsviks Kollektiva Konstnärs Verkstad at AIR – ARTIST IN RESIDENCE Niederösterreich, Krems, Austria

Örnsköldsviks Kollektiva Konstnärs Verkstad and AIR – ARTIST IN RESIDENCE Niederösterreich have conducted an annual residency exchange since 2011.

The international exchanges cultivate a critical context for the presentation and development of contemporary art, generating and reflecting contemporary practices to a broad audience locally, nationally and internationally. The residency project was formed through awareness that programs of this nature may represent a new condition in global practice in which arts practitioners operate at the edge-point of a new globalism characterised by mobility, fluidity and interactivity. The Artist in Residence exchange forms a 'location' through which the relationship of economics, politics and cultural identity can be examined and interrogated.

Applications for the Örnsköldsviks Kollektiva Konstnärs Verkstad / AIR – ARTIST IN RESIDENCE Niederösterreich Exchange

All applications must include:

1. Application form
2. Résumé in chart form, including artistic career and a list of previous grants (scholarships)
3. Statement of the applicant's artistic objectives during the residency [max. one to two European DIN A4 (210 x 297 mm) pages]
4. Not more than 10 images AND/OR 4 min (total video/sound) Please include digital files of work to be assessed. File must be named with sequential numbers. Other representative visual material of current artistic work, plans, etc. Images should be provided in JPG format and sound work in mp3 format.
5. Relevant support documentation, scanned images of articles, reviews or exhibition catalogues.
6. Applications with all of the above are to be presented as a pdf with the first page as a table of contents and listed sequentially in the above order. Sound or video works can be submitted alongside the pdf. The pdf size should not exceed 3 MB.

Provisions of the AIR – ARTIST IN RESIDENCE Niederösterreich residency during april following year.

The residency includes:

- A studio apartment appointed with a kitchen, bathroom, Internet access, telephone connection, dishwasher, washing machine, bedclothes and towels
- Access to the common room. The common room is also appointed with tools, computer, printer, photocopy machine and scanner
- cleaning service
- grant of 1300,- Euro (excluding travel-, transport- or material expenses) excluding health insurance, every scholarship holder needs to testify in advance a valid health insurance during his stay in Krems
- personal support for the duration of the residency
- curatorial support by curators of AIR – ARTIST IN RESIDENCE Niederösterreich
